NEW ISTQB WEBSITE GOES LIVE

On the 31st May 2010 the ISTQB released their new website. The website address remains unchanged as www.istqb.org. The website has been upgraded to include a new look and feel and to provide new and enhanced functionality and information for members of the ISTQB community.

Objectives of the new website

The new website was built to allow all members of the testing community to have greater access to information about ISTQB and the knowledge base it is accruing about testing.

A new more accessible website with expanded collaboration capability means more exposure to information about the testing profession.

Key Features:

- Greater access to the syllabi and glossary
- More information about the ISTQB member boards
- More information about ISTQB and its ongoing activities in the testing community
- More regular information available to interested all parties

What do the changes mean to the testing community?

The international testing community will now have clearer access to the ISTQB knowledge base, and have more exposure to the information available from ISTQB. In the near future there will be a knowledge base made available, as well as discussion forums. Testers will also be able to find out more information about their local member boards and their local training and exam providers.
